

High Hand Rules

High Hand for the evening will be paid \$100.00

ROYAL FLUSH will be highest hand

Ties for highest Royal Flush will be broken by Suit order - Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs

STRAIGHT FLUSH will be decided by highest Straight with King being highest, Queen next, etc.

Ties for highest Straight Flush will be broken by Suit order - Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs

FOUR OF A KIND will be decided by highest 4 cards ACEs being highest, Kings next, etc

Ties for highest Four of a kind will be broken by Suit order - Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs

FULL HOUSE will be decided by highest Set with ACEs being highest, Kings next, etc.

Ties for highest Full House will be divided equally by all players so tied.

Dealers must notify a Floor Director or the Tournament Director immediately after being shown a qualifying HIGH HAND.

All High Hands must be played to the river and shown to the dealer to qualify for HIGH HAND PRIZE.

Any high hand played only to the Flop or Turn does NOT qualify.

A High Hand held by any player after the river card is dealt qualifies for the High Hand Prize. If a player holds the high hand after the River Card is played, and all other players in the hand fold to any bet or call made by the holder of the High Hand, the player must show the hand to the dealer immediately to qualify for the high hand prize.

The High Hand must consist of at least one card from the player's hole cards. High hands consisting solely of the Board Cards do not qualify.
